



2012 QUILT SHOW CHALLENGE

Many quilters have been inspired by the New York Quilt Exhibit of red and white quilts. Quilt shows, quilt shops, magazines and quilters are off and running with this idea, eager to make red and white quilts. Bayberry's guild is no exception, challenging you to make a small quilt for our show. Here are the rules:

RED AND WHITE CHALLENGE: To use only red and white fabrics.

1. A sample of the preferred color red will be available at the meetings or by calling Ellie Held or Diane Hequembourg. Try to stay close to this color, away from burgundy, orange-red, or red-pink colors.
2. Multiple fabrics may be used as long as they are red, white, white-on-white, off-white, red with white print, white with red print. No prints that have other colors in them.
3. Choose your own design. Any style block, appliqué, or free-style form is acceptable.
5. May use red and/or white embellishments, embroidery, threads, thread painting, etc. Hand or machine quilted.
6. Maximum perimeter 100".
