Dear Friends,

We certainly did a great job with the challenge last year – there were serious interpretations, far out interpretations, sweet interpretations and wacky ones, too. I was impressed, once again, with the creativity displayed, and I know it was a great part of our show

So, let's do it again! Our challenge this year is: **THE SEASONS!**

There are no difficult rules, except for one: **SIZE**

The quilt **MUST hang vertically** and measure 18" on the top and bottom, 36" on the sides – a long rectangle.

Ideally, a scene would be preferred. However, some folks would rather interpret the season through fabric, color and pieced blocks, which is also acceptable. I hope to display the quilts in groups of 4, if possible—spring, summer, fall and winter hung together—this is an especially good idea if you have 3 buddies who would like to create 4 coordinating seasons to be hung together.

Finally, I would prefer no holidays—I'd rather have winter than Christmas, fall than Halloween etc.
