



## Seasons of Quilting 2018 Quilt Show

### Bayberry Theme Quilt

The theme for this year's quilt show is looking at the Seasons through Color. As we look at making a location change to this year's show, our theme quilts will also reflect change, as they highlight the colors of the changing seasons. Please choose one season for your quilt and pick the fabrics you feel will demonstrate and reflect that season. The colors you chose will reflect your opinion of the season you have chosen. You may embellish your quilt to add character and individuality. We hope to have many theme quilts on display at the show, each one using color to reflect one of the four seasons.

Some examples of possible colors choices:

- pastels colors to reflect the transition to **Spring**,
- blues and tans which reflect the colors of a beautiful beach day in **Summer**,
- oranges, browns, rusts and yellows for the changing colors of **Fall**
- white and black for the vivid contrasts of **Winter**.

These are only some examples where color coordinates with a season. You may see the season through a different lens of color. The colors you choose will reflect your interpretation of the season you have chosen. The quilt pattern can be a tradition pieced block, modern art quilt, appliquéd or a combination of pattern and design. Pick your season and let your color sense go wild, as we fill our new quilt display space with the colors of the seasons.
