

This is one for the VETS. Please make at LEAST one BOM and bring it to the April meeting. Someone will win all the blocks and have the start of a great quilt for the quilt bank! Feel free to use small prints instead of the solid red, white and blues as indicated. It's not as complicated as it looks- if you follow the diagrams, it's a cinch. I appreciate your service!

- CUT:** WHITE 2x 3 1/2" squares (A)  
 2x 4 1/4" squares (B) then cut diagonally TWICE  
 8x 2" squares (D)  
 4x 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangles (E)  
 BLUE: 8x 2 3/8" squares (C) cut in half diagonally  
 RED: 2x 2 1/2" X 6 1/2" rectangles (E)

**STEPS:** Follow diagram for placement of C and B triangles to make 8 flying geese rectangles.

Add two white squares (D) to each of 4 flying geese units.

Sew two flying geese units on opposite sides of each large white squares (A).

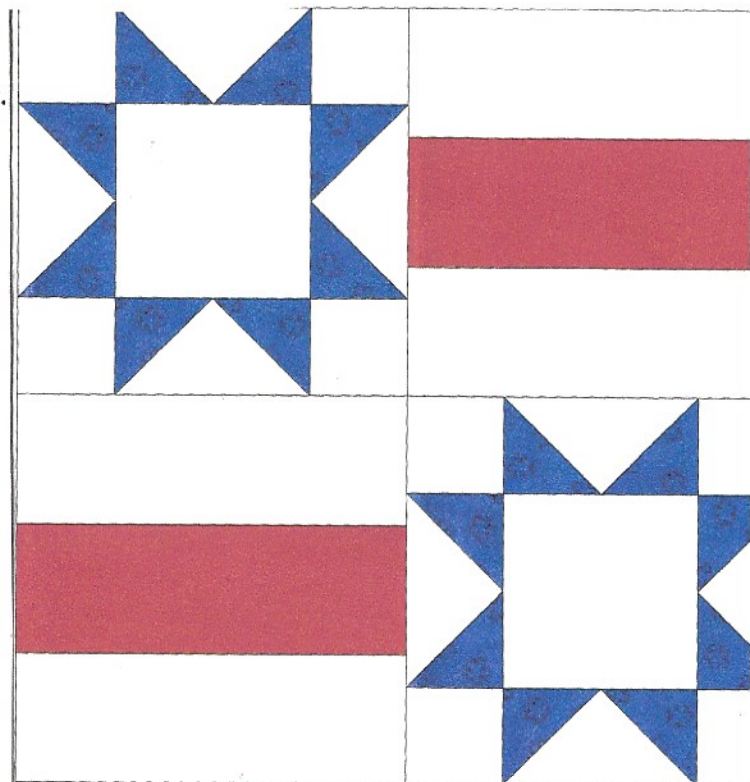
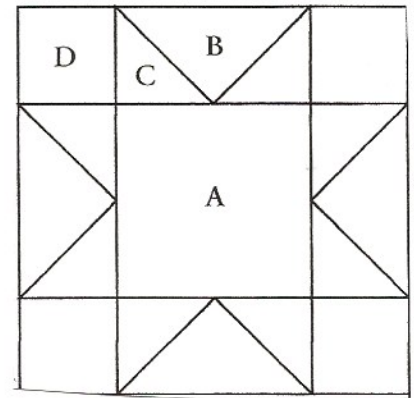
Put two star units together.

Using red and white rectangles (E) make two stripe blocks.

Join each stripe block to a star block.

Finally join two completed star/stripe blocks together.

Finished block will measure 12 1/2" square.



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
