This month's block is called the "MONKEY WRENCH", so I decided we should use "Manly" fabrics. Choose whatever that means to you.

Cutting:

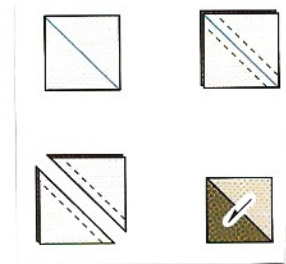
Light color #1: 4X- 1 1/2 X 5 rectangles 2X- 2 7/8 x 2 7/8 squares

Light color #2: 4X- 2x2 squares

Manly color #1: 4X- 1 1/2 x 5 rectangles

Manly color #2: 2X- 2 7/8 x 2 7/8 squares

Manly color #3: 5X- 2x2 squares



Piecing: Make 4 half square triangles for corners

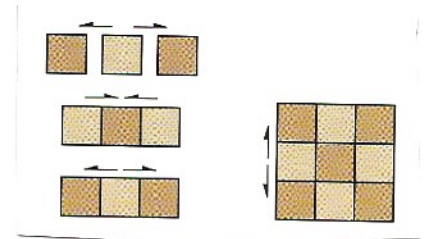
Make 4 corner blocks using the 2 7/8 squares.

Connect the 1 1/2 x 5 rectangles as shown.

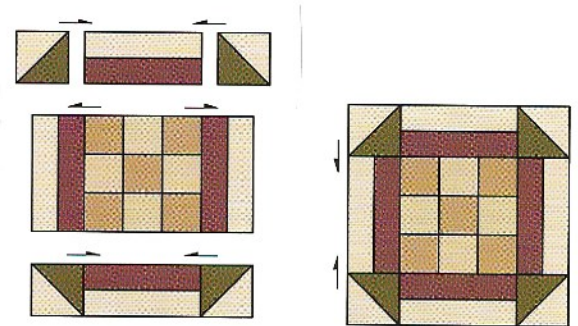
Make a 9-patch block using the 2" squares

Connect all the pieces as shown, pressing

In the directions indicated



VOILA: 9 inch square
