

Each month a block of the month pattern will be given out. To participate you must sew this block (or two). One ticket will be given out in exchange for each block that you enter. The winner will receive all the blocks.

**IF YOU PREFER NOT TO KEEP THE BLOCKS PLEASE DONATE THEM TO THE QUILT BANK**

SUPPLIES: Blue fabrics in Light, Medium and Dark values Cream (neutral) fabric

CUTTING: Blue: Cut (2) strips of each 16" x 1 1/2'

Cream: Cut (4) pieces 3 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Cut (4) pieces 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

CONSTRUCTION:

Sew the three strips together and cut into (4) 7 1/2" segments

On the wrong side of the 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles draw a 45 degree lines from both corners as shown. To draw the lines align the 45 degree of a ruler to the bottom of the rectangle, making sure the edge of the

ruler goes through the corner of the rectangle



Stack the striped units with the same fabric on top. Place a beige rectangle on the right of the striped rectangle and sew thru both lines.



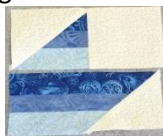
Cut between the two lines and press toward the cream on both pieces



Sew 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" cream square to small half-square triangle. Press the seams toward the cream.



Arrange a unit with a striped rectangle to make a quarter block. Make four identical blocks.



Rotate blocks as pictured and sew.
