

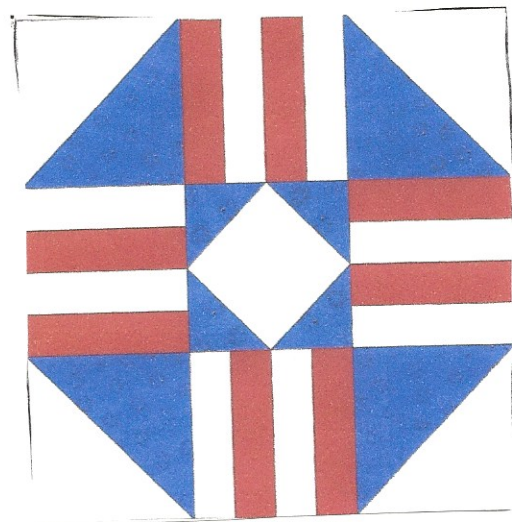
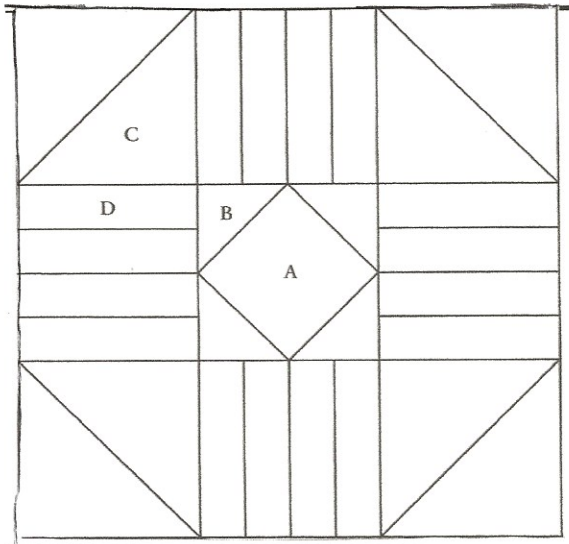
By popular demand, we are beginning the year with a quilt block appropriate for use in a Veteran's Quilt. As you probably know, Lou will want at least 100 Vet's Quilts by Memorial Day. Trying something different, I will give you a ticket to possibly win ALL the January Blocks, only if you want to make one such quilt! I will give you Feb and Mar BOMs that would fit in with this block! So, get out the Red, White and Blue to begin. This block is called "Crossroad". Block will measure 12 1/2" square.

Cutting:

- White 1x 3 3/8" square (A)
- 2x 4 7/8" squares (C) Cut in half diagonally making 4 triangles
- 8x 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (D)
- Red 8x 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (D)
- Blue 2x 4 7/8" squares (C) Cut in half diagonally making 4 triangles
- 2x 2 7/8" squares (B) Cut in half diagonally making 4 triangles

Steps:

- Make 4 squares piecing together red and white rectangles (D)
- Make 4 squares piecing together blue and white large triangles (C)
- Make center square using A square and small blue triangles (B)
- Connect horizontal squares, then connect vertical squares.
