

BAYBERRY QUILTERS OF CAPE COD
QUILT SHOW ENTRY GUIDELINES - 2022

The quilt maker must be a Bayberry Guild member, except Youth quilts.

1. Quilts will consist of three layers: top, backing, and some type of batting or filler with a stitch that penetrates all three layers. Entries must be quilted by hand, domestic machine or longarm.
2. Quilts must have been completed after August 2019 and cannot have been exhibited in the contest at a previous Bayberry show.
3. All quilt Registration Forms and photos must be submitted by MAY 15th
4. Curators have the discretion to limit the number of quilts per quilt maker.
5. Curators have the discretion to move an entry from one category to another.
6. Quilt size is limited to a maximum of 120" x 120".
7. Every quilt, no matter what size with, is required to have a 4" hanging sleeve; the exception being the Educational Exhibit quilts (which require a 2" sleeve). 4" sleeve instructions on website.
8. Every quilt must have an attached label with the quilter's name, quilt title, and date of completion.
9. If a specific pattern is used from a book, magazine, or designer, the name of pattern, designer, and source (name of book, magazine, etc.) must be included in the quilt description.
10. Quilt withdrawal notification **MUST be sent by email** to Noreen Couture.
11. **Policy for selling quilts:** All quilt sales will be handled through the Boutique. When a quilt is sold, full payment will be made to the seller. The seller is responsible for paying Bayberry a 10% fee of the total received for the quilt sold. A sales receipt must be filled in by both the seller and the buyer. The sales receipt will be attached to the back of the quilt when the quilt is registered. After the sale, one part of the receipt will be retained by the Boutique, the other to be retained by the buyer who will present it at the end of the show for pick up. The sold quilt must remain on display until the end of the quilt show.

RIBBON CATEGORY DEFINITIONS:

Viewer's Choice Awards:

1. **Quilts** - Hand Quilted, Quilted by Other, Member Quilted, Small Quilt. See Registration Form for specifications.
2. **Art Quilt** – must be quilted. Must be an exploration of an original concept by the maker. Features abstract, cutting edge, and non-literal elements. No commercial patterns.
3. **Fiber Arts** – Articles must have a fabric base. Clothing, bags, pictures, etc. Quilts do not fall into this category.

Bayberry Ribbons:

1. **Viewer's Choice (1st, 2nd, 3rd, Honorable Mention)**
2. **First Entry in a Quilt Show** – Quilt maker's first-ever entry in a show. (Only one ribbon will be given to quilter for this category)

Non-Ribbon Categories:

1. **Featured Quilter(s)** – Selected by show chairs.
2. **Educational Exhibit:** Must be a small quilt exhibiting a new skill or technique learned during pandemic. Name the skill in the description on the Registration Form.
3. **In Memoriam** – Quilts displayed by pre-arrangement with show chair or curator.
