

**Block of the Month 2022-2023, January**

**Reminder: Sewn blocks should MEASURE  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square to finish to 12".**

This block has 3 colors. Color A is darkest, Color B is medium, and Color C is lightest.

Cutting instructions:

Color A (black in photo) darkest

Eight  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

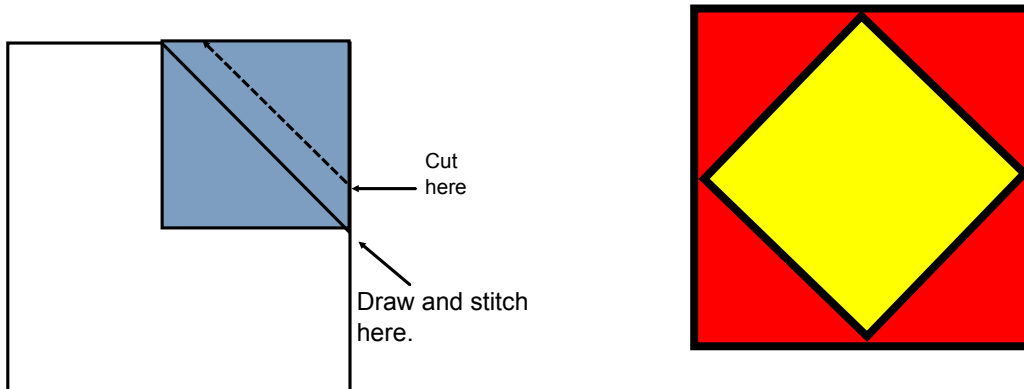
Color B (red in photo) medium

Eight  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (draw diagonals on four of these squares)

Color C (yellow in photo) mediumest

One  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square

Sew one color B square onto opposite corners of the large color C square. Sew on the diagonal line you drew. Cut off outer triangle  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch from your sewn line. Press open and repeat to the other two corners of the large square. One is shown below. When you are finished, you will have a square in a square unit like the diagram to the right.



Sew remaining squares together according to the layout.

Refer to the photo and diagram for placement of the blocks when piecing.
