

2023 Road Trip Challenge

Please note, these are adjusted and revised as requested to replace the previous instructions!

This Challenge is to depict a scene when on a road trip. It can be as simple or as complicated as you wish-a hometown scene, or a magnificent National Park.

Requirements:

1. Size: 24" wide and 20" tall
2. Binding- none, do not use traditional binding- "pillowcase it", so it will connect with neighbor quilts without interruption.
3. Road will be consistently 2" wide, dark grey, **which will be provided**. Contact Diana Anderson at Diana@proevent.com with your mailing address and she will send the fabric, which is a 2.5" wide strip of bias tape, this will allow for 1/4" seam allowances and 2" wide, finished, road. The road fabric will also be available at the meetings after the holidays.
4. Placement, the road will start on the left side, and end on the right side, both sides 9" up from the bottom, and 9" down from the top. It can meander any which way you like in between. This will allow for space on both sides of the road for "wherever you want to go!", and still be able to match up with the next adventuring quilt..
5. Register your quilt by the May Wednesday meeting.

Have Fun and be creative! City, farm, town, mountains, lakes, deserts, shops, wheat fields,-what a wonder! Cars and trucks are optional. Coloring books are a great way to break down your design if you are having difficulty.
